



## **WEEKEND RULES**

### **FIRE AND SAFETY REGULATIONS**

- Cars must be parked in the parking lot at all times, except to deliver supplies to the kitchen.
- Cars must be backed into parking spaces.
- No open fires except at campfire area. Fire danger is extreme so please keep your campfire small and put it completely out when you are done. Only propane bottle stoves and lanterns, or battery lanterns are allowed in campsites.
- Barbecuing is allowed only in Corral barbecue pits.
- Smoking is only allowed at the designated smoking area by the parking lot restrooms.
- No consumption of alcohol or illegal drugs.
- No sleeping in second story of headquarters building.
- No pets in camp.
- No motorcycles or ATVs in camp. (Forest Service roads in this area are closed to off road vehicles.) Bikes only allowed up the canyon.
- Campers are not allowed at Lake Wood without adult supervision.
- Cub Scouts are not allowed to use canoes unless it is a Ventura County Council sanctioned event.

### **FIREARMS**

- Shooting of firearms is only allowed at shooting ranges.
- No hand guns allowed.
- Maximum rifle size is .22 caliber single shot, no automatic rifles and no high caliber rifles with exception of black powder rifles with .50 caliber maximum.

### **GRAFFITI and PROPERTY DAMAGE**

- Graffiti and property damage on camp property is not tolerated. Leaders must check buildings, cabins, and restrooms. Any graffiti or damage must be removed, repaired and/or paid for before leaving.

### **FREEZE PROTECTION (Winter Camp Only)**

- Let cold water trickle at night in the kitchen sink and restroom sink to prevent freezing of pipes.

## **PARKING LOT RESTROOMS**

- The code for the restrooms is available upon request. You must press the lock symbol when exiting. Campers are responsible for the cleaning of the restrooms. It is recommended that only adults use these restrooms.

## **ENTRANCE GATE**

- For camp security, please keep the main entry gate closed at all times.

## **CLEANING**

- All facilities used are to be cleaned. The kitchen and dining hall should be swept, mopped, and tables and chairs stacked on carts.
- The restrooms, headquarters, and Fremlin Hall, if used, should be swept and trash emptied.
- Kitchen grill should be left shiny and clean. (Ask for grill cleaning supplies and cleaning instructions.)

## **TRASH**

- All of your trash must be hauled to the dumpster by the creek crossing. Trash needs to be picked up from all areas used-campsites, restrooms, cabins, and buildings.
- New trash can liners need to be put back in trash cans. (provided)

## **TRADING POST**

- If you would like to have the Trading Post open during your visit, please let the camp master know prior to your stay.

## **TELEPHONE**

- The camp phone number is (661) 245-1206. The telephone is for emergency use only. Use a calling card or make a collect call if you need to make a personal call. Directions for making a phone call are next to the phone.
- ATT and Verizon cell phones work in camp.
- Campmaster's phone number will be provided.

## **RANGER'S HOUSE**

- The Ranger's house is a private residence and the campers need to respect the occupant's privacy and not walk through the area surrounding the house.
