Campout overview

- Camping begins Saturday morning **October 13** and continues through Sunday morning **October 14**.
- Families may optionally arrive Friday **October 12 after 4:00 PM** and spend the night before the Cub Scout Overnight
- **The cost per camper is \$31.** The cost is the same for campers staying either one or two nights.
- **Scouts must attend with a parent or guardian.** Additional family members may attend if space permits.

Location and Directions

3000 Rustic Canyon Rd. Pacific Palisades, CA 90272 - Josepho is located less than 15 minutes from Sunset Boulevard in the Pacific Palisades. Take the 405 San Diego Freeway and exit at Sunset Blvd. Take Sunset Blvd. west toward the beach for about 3 miles. Turn right on Capri Drive. You will get to a round-about. Take it around until you find Capri Drive again. Stay on Capri Drive until the end and turn left on to Casale Road. Casale will curve around the hill and turn into a dirt road. You will come to a gate to enter Sullivan Fire Road. The road is gated with regularly changed gate codes required for access. **Make sure to get the 4 digit code for the gate before you arrive.**

The fire road is open to hikers and cyclists. There are a number of blind curves on the road, and, for safety, drivers must extend courtesies to other people on the road. The speed limit on the road is 10 M.P.H. Drive on Sullivan Fire road for about 1.8 miles. The entrance to Camp Josepho Boy Scout Camp will be on your left, marked by a wooden arch.

Schedule

Arrive at camp Friday afternoon/evening or early Saturday morning. If you arrive Friday you will need to prepare your own Friday dinner and Saturday breakfast. Return home on Sunday.
